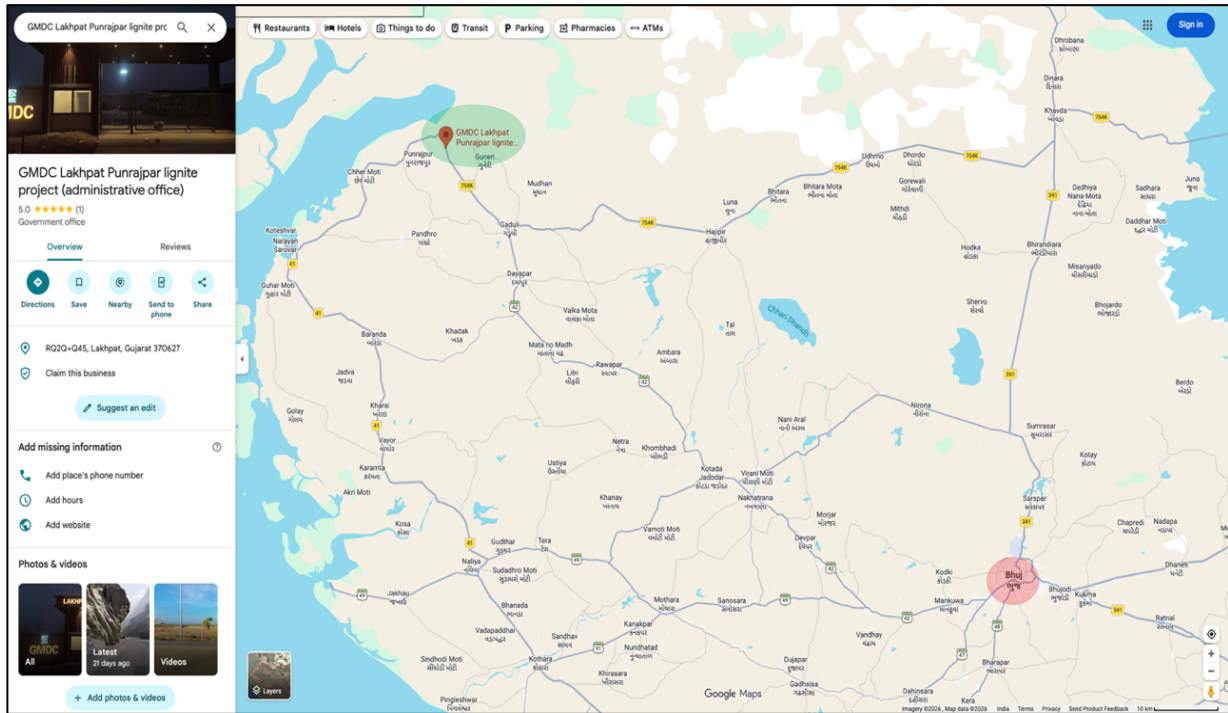

2. About GMDC

Gujarat Mineral Development Corporation Limited herein after referred to as GMDC, a Government of Gujarat Enterprise, is a pioneer company in the field of mining for six decades, catering to the needs of the minerals and solid fuel for the industries based in Gujarat. GMDC's mining activities are spread all over Gujarat. It is currently dealing in minerals like Lignite, Bauxite, Fluorspar, Ball Clay, Silica sand and Manganese. GMDC has also setup a 250MW lignite based Thermal Power Station at Nani Chher in Kutch, Wind power plant of 200.9 MW at Maliya, Jodiya, Godsar, Bhanvad, Bada, Varvada, Rojmal and Solar Power plant of 5 MW at Panandhro Project. The upcoming opencast mine, namely Lakhpat–Punrajpur Project, is presently at the final stage of commencement with an envisaged production capacity of 29.81 MTPA of limestone and 3 MTPA of lignite.

3. Location of Work

The work required to be carried out is located at Lakhpat Punrajpur Lignite Project, Village Lakhpat Taluka in Kutch District of the Gujarat State. The nearest Railway Station and Airport is at Bhuj-Kutch. NH75K passes through the lease area. Nearby villages include Lakhpat, Kaner, and Punrajpur.

4. General Instructions to Bidder

The section aims to provide guidelines/Instructions for Bidders, to be used while submitting the Proposals.

4.1 **Cost of Bidding**

The Bidder will bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its bid and GMDC LTD., will in no event or circumstance be held responsible or liable for these costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the bidding process.

4.2 **Due Diligence**

The Bidder is expected to and shall be deemed to have examined all instructions, forms, terms and specifications and other information in this Tender Document. The bid should be precise, complete and in the prescribed format as per the requirement of the Tender Document. Failure to furnish all information required by the Tender Document or submission of a bid not responsive to the Tender Document in every respect will be at the Bidder's risk and may result



in rejection of the bid. GMDC shall at its sole discretion be entitled to determine the adequacy/sufficiency of the information provided by the Bidder.

4.3 Clarification of Bidding Documents

GMDC shall make best efforts to respond to any request for clarification of the Tender Document. The response/clarification shall to the extent possible be made in writing.

4.4 Amendment of tender Document

At any time before the deadline for submission of bids, GMDC LTD may modify the tender Document for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Bidder, modify the Tender Document by amending, modifying and/or supplementing the same. Any amendments/modifications in the tender document would be displayed on GMDC Website/(n) procure website and all such amendments shall be binding on the Bidder without any further act or deed on GMDC LTD part. 4.6 Language of Bid

All Proposals and various documents related to these Proposals should be in English Language.

All correspondence between GMDC LTD., and the Bidder would also be in English Language.



Supporting Documents and Printed Literature furnished by the Bidder may be in another Language provided the same are accompanied by an accurate translation in English Language.

4.7 Late Bids

Any bid received by GMDC LTD after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by GMDC LTD., summarily rejected. GMDC LTD shall not be responsible for any postal delay or non-receipt /non-delivery of the documents. No further correspondence on this subject will be entertained.

4.8 Right to Accept Proposal

GMDC LTD reserves the right to accept or reject any Proposal, and to annul the Proposal process and reject all Proposals at any time prior to award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or any obligation to inform the affected Consortium of the grounds for such decision.

4.9 Site Visit

Before submitting the bids, the bidders should visit the area to study the actual working conditions, location & route of electrical line and ascertain the logistic and facilities available or to be generated for carrying out electrical works.

Any neglect or failure on the part of the Bidder in obtaining necessary and reliable information upon the foregoing or any other matters affecting the contract shall not relieve him from any risks or liabilities or the entire responsibility from completion of the work at the contracted rates and time in strict accordance with the contract documents.

4.10 Period of Validity of Bids

Bids shall remain valid for 180 days after the date of bid opening prescribed by GMDC LTD, pursuant to the Tender schedule mentioned in this document. In exceptional circumstances, GMDC LTD may solicit the Bidder's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the response thereto shall be made in writing. Extension of validity period by the Bidder shall be unconditional.



4.11 Subcontract

The Successful bidder shall not assign or sub-contract any portion of this work without prior written consent of GMDC.

4.12 Consortium / Joint Venture

Consortium / Joint Venture are not allowed.

4.13 Change in Law

Nothing in this contract shall entitle the Bidder to claim additional payment against the work executed or being executed or likely to be executed upon the change in law by Government of India or State of Gujarat as regards any taxes, liabilities arising out of work contract, judgments of court etc. That nothing under the said laws shall create any additional liability on the GMDC over and above that set out herein. That unforeseen circumstances in the working of the said contract shall not entitle Successful Bidder to abandon or demand additional payment under a different head not originally mentioned herein and hence nothing except what is contained in the present contract shall constitute binding obligations between parties.

4.14 Interpretation

That no communication preceding or following the present tender shall have any bearing on the terms and conditions set out in this document. No extra contract, promise or obligation shall arise out of the said communication, over and above what is set out in this document. That the terms contained in this document constitute the entire bargain between the parties and shall not be interpreted in the light of commercial correspondence between the parties.

4.15 Declaration

7.2 The successful bidder shall submit security deposit of 10% of the total contract value excluding Goods & Service Tax (GST) at within 10 days from the date of receipt of acceptance of LOA in any one of following form.

9. Eligibility and Qualification Criteria of Bidder

9.1 Experience

The Bidders should have following minimum experience of having successfully completed similar works during last 7 (seven) years ending on last day of May 2026 (i.e. period from 01.05.2019 to 31.05.2026):

- A. Three similar completed works each having amount of Rs. 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakhs only) or more during last 7 (seven) years ending on last day of May 2026 (i.e. period from 01.05.2019 to 31.05.2026)

OR

- B. Two similar completed works each having amount of Rs. 60,00,000/- (Rupees Sixty Lakhs only) or more during last 7 (seven) years ending on last day of May 2026 (i.e. period from 01.05.2019 to 31.05.2026)

OR



- C. One similar completed work having amount of Rs 80,00,000/- (Rupees Eighty Lakhs Only) or more during last 7 (seven) years ending on last day of May 2026 (i.e. period from 01.05.2019 to 31.05.2026)

Similar works means the Bidders should have experience in one or more works of 11KV and above Over Head as well Under Ground HT line Supply, Installation, Testing and Commissioning work and should have been carried out under the single LOA/Work Order/Agreement.

Bidder should have valid Electrical contractor license issued by Government of Gujarat under Government Notification, Energy and Petrochemicals Department no. GU/2013/37/ELA/11-2012/2401/K Dated 22.04.2013 for carrying out Electrical installation Works in Gujarat State. Bidder shall have to submit the same.

Bidder shall submit the details of work completed in form PC as provided in the Tender Document Separate year wise Statement of experience with work orders and work executed certificates (Work Completion Certificate) duly certified by the certificate issuing authority shall be submitted as supporting documents.

9.2 Financial

- 9.2.1 Bidder must have an average positive Net Worth as on last three financial year of 31.03.2023, 31.03.2024 and 31.03.2025.
- 9.2.2 Bidder must have a Minimum Average Turnover of Rs 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakhs only) for last three financial year ending on 31.03.2025.
- 9.2.3 A certificate from Chartered Accountant regarding financial capacity shall be submitted as per format provided in FORM PC of the Tender Document.

9.3 Site Visit Certificate

If the bidder visit the site prior to submission of bid, they should give a declaration of site visit as per the format provided in FORM PG of the Tender Document.



9.4 Blacklisting of the Bidder

The Bidder or its directors have not been blacklisted by any Government Organization. The Bidder will submit a declaration to this effect as per the format provided in FORM PD of the Tender Document. If at any time such declaration is found false, the bid will be rejected or if the contract work is already awarded, it will be terminated forthwith without payment of any compensation and the EMD/SD will be forfeited.

10. Evaluation of Bids

10.1 Completeness of Bids

GMDC, will examine the bids to determine whether they are complete, whether they meet all the conditions of the Tender Document and Technical Specifications, whether any computational errors have been made, whether required sureties have been furnished, whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the Bid Documents are substantially responsive to the requirements of the Tender Document.

10.2 Tender Clarifications

The GMDC may at its discretion, seek from any or all bidders, clarifications on his/their bids, including technical information, documents and materials after technical bid opening but before opening of commercial bid.

10.3 Rejection of Bid

A bid that does not meet all eligibility criteria or is not responsive shall be rejected by GMDC. Submission of false or incorrect information, history of delayed work, reports of unprofessional conduct, among other things, shall be sufficient grounds for disqualification in technical bid.

10.4 Opening of Bids

Technical bids will be opened after verification of receipt of payment towards Tender Processing Fee and EMD. Relaxation in terms of submission of EMD shall be given to the bidder who is holding valid Certificate issued under the MSME Act, 2006 on the date of



submission of Tender. On verification of the supporting documents, technical qualification of the bidders will be assessed. The eligible bidders will be communicated the date and time of online opening of price bids by fax or telephone or email or SMS. However, all successful bidders will be able to view the price bids online on their computers after opening of price bid.

10.5 Selection of Bidder

The contract will be awarded to the bidder who stands L1 in total price. The GMDC reserves its right to reject any or all tenders or split the job between more than one bidder without assigning any reason and thereby without incurring any liability to the affected successful bidder or Bidders or any obligation to inform the affected successful bidder or successful bidder's of the grounds for GMDC Ltd., action/decision.

10.6 Discussion

It is essential for the successful bidders to quote the lowest price at the time of making the offer in their own interest. GMDC, however, will have the discretion to choose to enter any mode of discussion or not.

10.7 Acceptance of LOA

10.7.1 GMDC, on acceptance of the offer, will issue Letter of Award (LOA) to the successful bidder, who will be required to confirm its acceptance of the LOA within 7 days from the date of receipt. If he does not accept the LOA within stipulated period, the amount of the EMD paid will be forfeited and necessary further actions may be initiated as may be deemed fit by the GMDC.

10.7.2 The Successful bidder shall have to execute agreement duly notarized on Stamp paper of Rs. 300 and submit the Security Deposit with within 30 days from the date of acceptance of LOA. The Successful bidder shall submit the Security Deposit in the manner prescribed in this Tender Document after that issuance of work order. In case of failure to submit the security deposit, the amount of EMD will be forfeited and necessary further actions may be initiated as may be deemed fit by the GMDC.



10.7.3 In case of any necessity arising after issuing LOA and during the execution of the work, which requires alteration/modifications in the agreement, the same can be made in writing after mutual understanding and consent of both the parties.

10.7.4 The duration of the contract is valid for a period of 120 days from the date of acceptance of LOA.

11. Scope of Work

The successful bidder shall be required to carry out following job:

Note: This is the indicative Scope; however successful bidder has to carry out work as per actual requirements at the time of procurement and execution of contract work. Payment will be made as per the same.

11.1 Route Survey & Alignment

The contractor shall conduct a detailed route survey for the proposed 11 kV line, considering site conditions such as haul roads, dump yards, and machinery movement zones to ensure minimal interference with mining operations.

The alignment and pole locations shall be optimized for safety, efficiency, and reduced clearance requirements because of overhead line, while complying with applicable standards.

The contractor shall submit a route map indicating the finalized alignment and a detailed pole schedule for approval prior to execution.

11.2 Supply of Materials

Contractor shall supply the following materials for proper installation of 11 kV line. The list is indicative and not limited to. Successful bidder will have to supply proper and sufficient materials

11.3 Erection of Poles

The contractor shall carry out excavation, pole erection, and concreting as per approved standards. Alignment shall be ensured considering optimal sag and conductor tension. Suitable brackets for insulated conductors shall be provided, and all statutory clearances shall be maintained.

11.4 Stringing of Insulated Conductor

The contractor shall undertake stringing of 11 kV covered conductor/aerial cable using appropriate rollers and tensioning equipment. Care shall be taken to avoid any damage to insulation during stringing. Sag and tension shall be maintained as per manufacturer's specifications, and only insulated clamps shall be used.

11.5 Installation of Accessories

The contractor shall supply and install all necessary accessories including suspension clamps, dead-end clamps, spacers, and insulated cross-arms/brackets. Proper phase spacing shall be maintained throughout the line. Bare conductor such as ACSR shall not be permitted. Only insulated covered conductor system shall be used.

11.6 Earthing System

Proper earthing of all poles and associated equipment shall be carried out as per relevant standards. Earthing of the system is mandatory, notwithstanding the use of insulated conductors.

11KV OH Line earthing Specification-Supply of approved make safe Earthing Electrode consisting of pipe -in- pipe Technology as per IS-3043-1987 made of corrosion free G.I. Pipe having outer pipe dia of 80 mm having 80-200 Micron galvanizing, Inner pipe dia of 40 mm. having 200-250 Micron galvanizing, connecting terminal dia of 14mm with constant ohmic



value surrounding by highly conductive compound with high charge dissipation suitable for pressure filled with CCM. (A) Length of pipe minimum 2 m.

Substation has to be equipped with Twenty-six no. of chemical earth pit of 2.5” pipe with chamber (two for transformer neutral, two for Transformer body / CSS, Two for LT panel Body, four nos. for LA, four for DP structure body, two for DG body and two for DG netrul, one for fencing and seven for OH line). Provide ACP sheet (8”x7”) Tag with 2’ long GI stand for Earthing pit identification.

To provide earth pit at every four to five pole span in 11KV OH line addition to each pole separate GI coil earthing.

Earthing shall be as per CEAR2023 guidelines & IS 3043(1987)

11.7 Special Considerations

The insulated overhead system shall be designed to minimize risks of flashover and faults arising from contact with trees, dust, or moving equipment. The system shall enhance safety in the mining environment. Working at nighttime shall only be done with prior approval from GMDC

11.8 DGMS and other Clearances

The contractor shall ensure that all works are carried out in strict compliance with applicable statutory requirements and regulations. All clearances, safety norms, and installation practices shall conform to the guidelines issued by the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) and the Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS) including NOC for road crossing (NH754K / SH42) from R & B department of Appropriate govt authority. The contractor shall be responsible for adherence to all relevant standards, obtaining necessary approvals from DGMS as per CEA for all installations, material etc, and ensuring safe and compliant execution of the work.



11.9 Testing & Commission

The contractor shall carry out all necessary testing and commissioning of the installed system to ensure its safety, reliability, and operational readiness. This shall include, but not be limited to, High Voltage (Hi-Pot) testing, Insulation Resistance (IR/Megger) testing, visual inspection of insulation, continuity testing, insulation integrity checks, and earthing tests. All tests shall be conducted using calibrated instruments and in accordance with relevant standards and manufacturer recommendations.

The entire testing and commissioning process shall strictly comply with the guidelines and statutory requirements of the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) and the Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS). Detailed test reports and commissioning certificates shall be submitted for approval prior to energization of the system. Before commissioning contractor must acquire NOC from local Electrical Inspector.

GMDC shall provide CSS box for operationalisation of the electrical line, the successful bidder shall connect the 11 kV line with the CSS Box to establish secure and working electrical circuit complying with all performance parameters.

Even if installation work is completed and project is complying with the performance parameters, the Project shall only be considered commissioned if all Statutory & Obligatory Approvals are obtained and submitted to GMDC.

11.10 Safety Compliance

The contractor shall ensure that all installations are suitable for the mining environment, with adequate provisions for enhanced safety against accidental contact and potential equipment collision. All works shall strictly comply with applicable safety regulations, including those of the Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS). Use of appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) by all personnel at site shall always be mandatory. As per CENTRAL ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY (MEASURES RELATING TO SAFETY AND ELECTRIC SUPPLY) REGULATIONS, 2023 Reg. 75, Anti-climbing arrangement shall be provided on each pole/tower. Barbed wires conforming to relevant standards for a vertical distance of 30–40 cm at a height of 3.5–4.0 m from ground level or clamps with protruding spikes at a height



of 3–4 m shall be provided. Also, as per CENTRAL ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY (MEASURES RELATING TO SAFETY AND ELECTRIC SUPPLY) REGULATIONS, 2023 Reg. 72, in case of line crossing at haul road or others provide guarding between two poles in 11KV OH Line.

11.11 Documentation

The contractor shall submit complete documentation upon completion of work, including as line diagrams with specifications, cable datasheets, and all relevant test reports, approvals from DGMS and other govt authorities viz R & B department of Gujarat etc under various laws pertaining to mine. All documents shall be duly certified and submitted for record and approval.

11.12 Technical Specifications

All materials shall be new, of approved quality, and conform to relevant IS/ISO/BIS/ISI standards, approved by NABL accreditation and follow guidelines of the Central Electricity Authority (CEA) and Directorate General of Mines Safety (DGMS). The equipment / materials supplied shall confirm to the latest edition of Indian / International Standards, REC Standards, Indian Electricity Rules, relevant code of practices and requirements of chief Electrical Inspector of Govt. of Gujarat and also that of DGMS and other state and central regulatory authorities.

A. For Overhead Line, the line shall be supported on 8 m PSC poles of minimum 200 kg working load, suitable for 11 kV applications in mining conditions. MVCC AL-55 covered conductor (55 sq. mm) shall be used, offering enhanced safety, reduced clearance requirements, and resistance to environmental conditions. GI earthing wire and aluminium binding wire shall be provided for proper earthing continuity and secure conductor fastening. Insulation shall be ensured using 11 kV pin insulators with GI pins and 45kN disc insulators with standard hardware. Structural components such as MS cross arms, pole top brackets/cleats, DP structure angle sets, and all clamps, nuts, bolts, and washers shall be hot-dip galvanized and designed to withstand mechanical and environmental stresses. Safety provisions shall include HT stay sets, earthing arrangements, 11 kV 400 Amp outdoor Air



Break Switches (ABS), lightning arrestors, LED indicators/reflectors, and standard danger plates with pole numbering, ensuring safe and compliant operation in mining environments. The maximum line span between two poles shall be maintained 30/35 meters. DP structure (i.e. Two pole structure with DO fuse along with ABS, LA etc) shall provide at every four to five poles spans with stay / Guy wire support at every require poles. Guy / Stay wire shall provide at every pole where it is required specially at turning & ending point of OH line. Some portion of land, above which some poles are to be erected, is filled with OB / ordinary clay up to 5 m as such potential bidder shall take all care for strengthening of work during erection of pole in this area. Every PSC pole, DP structures shall be locally earthed by coil earthing of 8-gauge GI wires. 11.14 Commissioning

After erection and laying of all equipment under this contract and getting due clearance of DGMS, electrical inspector, the System shall be taken in service and shall be under observation for at least 72 hours of trouble-free performance for commissioning of the system.

11.15 Special Terms and Condition of the Contract with Reference to Scope of Work:

1. All type of Mobilization, demobilization and local conveyance for crew deployed for the work shall be in successful bidder's scope. Successful bidder shall submit list of your crew members including supervisor, engineer and materials for preparing gate pass before executing the job.
2. All consumables required for the completion of work shall be in successful bidder's scope.
3. Lighting arrangement shall be in accordance with safety norm shall be in successful bidder's scope.
4. Daily progress report shall be submitted.
5. The successful bidder shall abide by and ensure compliance of all labor laws, insurance, workman compensation act & all applicable statutory rules and regulations for subject work.
6. The successful bidder must fulfill all the safety regulations and take all necessary safety measures to avoid any hazard and shall be strictly followed by persons deployed by the successful bidder for the job. To ensure safety regulations, instruction and directives given by GMDC safety officer shall be final and binding to the successful Bidder.
7. The successful bidder shall be solely responsible for any accident to his / their workers and should adhere to all rules and regulations as per labor laws of Government and other statutory authority. The successful bidder shall ensure that all persons employed by the successful bidder use personal protective equipment's.



8. The successful bidder shall keep GMDC indemnified from all liabilities arising out of his action in pursuance of this contract.
9. All persons deployed by the successful bidder shall maintain due discipline and GMDC reserves the right to take disciplinary action if required.
10. The Successful Bidder shall keep one or more nominated competent person(s) as a Supervisor in each area of work to supervise quality of work and effective progress of work as scheduled and report submission to EIC of GMDC.
11. All the tools & tackles required to carry out the work shall be in successful bidder's scope.
12. All works related to hoists, Cranes, and other lifting tools, etc. for lifting, shifting of the materials is in successful bidder's scope. The successful bidder has to arrange all resources for the same. Any reason for delay of the work for the want of the resources shall not be considered.
13. For the items, which are not supplied, or the works, which are not being carried out by the successful bidder, as the case may be, shall be completed at the risk and cost of the successful bidder.

15. The successful bidder shall attend meeting at any time called by GMDC management and shall apprise day to day work progress carried out during the work.
16. Safety during the installation shall be maintained,
 - For all the safety appliances/kits required for the personnel during erection and commissioning, the bidder shall arrange the same.
 - The safety precautions shall conform to norms set by relevant safety regulations and Safety practices.
 - As per the requirements, the Agency shall provide danger boards, safety charts, fire extinguishers, sand buckets etc. at all substations.
 - All the workers of the Agency should have training in safety before starting the work.
17. Documents and drawings to be supplied



- Single line diagrams with specifications.
- Complete set of drawings for the electrical system indicating Structural, Architectural, Illumination, Ventilation details.
- Drawings for operation, protection & control.
- General Arrangement drawings.
- Power supply distribution scheme.
- Technical literature/ catalogues
- Datasheets of the equipment offered.
- Wiring diagram.
- System Configuration Drawing.
- Power Distribution Scheme.
- Earthing Scheme.
- Communication Drawing.
- Operation manuals for each of the equipment.
- Original bills of materials (if any) for warranty/guaranty purpose.

12. Period and Duration of Work

12.1 The duration of the contract is valid for a period of 120 days from the date of acceptance of LOA. However, period of contract may be extended for maximum period of 90 days on the same terms and conditions of the contract subject to approval from Competent authority and the entire satisfaction of GMDC.

12.2 Time and quality are the essence of the contract and successful bidder has to complete the work accordingly. Looking to this, Successful bidder has to complete the work within 120 days from the date of intimation from GMDC.

12.3 The successful bidder shall maintain the 11 kV HT line during the Defect Liability Period (DLP) of three (3) years from commissioning. The successful bidder shall provide a comprehensive warranty of one (1) year from commissioning for all materials supplied and shall rectify any defects arising during this period at no cost to GMDC, including material replacement, labour, and workmanship charges. Further, during the second and third years of the DLP (after expiry of the initial warranty period), GMDC shall bear only the cost of replacement materials, if required; while all labour, workmanship, and maintenance charges shall remain the responsibility of the successful bidder.

12.4 In case of any reason including adverse working conditions during execution of the contract that may compel suspension/closure of the contract, GMDC shall be at liberty to conclude/postpone/complete/terminate/foreclose this contract. No compensation or payment shall be made on account of afore-stated events. Decision of GMDC in this regard shall be final and binding to the Successful Bidder.

12.5 GMDC reserves the right to review and assess the performance of the work at any time during the contract period. In case of poor or unsatisfactory performance and / or breach of any terms and conditions of the contract, GMDC shall have discretion to take appropriate action including termination of the contract.

12.6 All the activities arising under the scope of the works shall be complied with various statute/laws/Rules/Regulations etc. including Environmental laws and if the Successful Bidder fails to comply the laws; it will be done at the risk and cost of the Successful Bidder and expenses will be recovered from Bills of the Successful Bidder.

12.7 The Successful Bidder shall have to follow all safety norms. The Successful Bidder shall be responsible for safety of equipment's and plants. If any damages occur, then the Successful



Bidder shall be responsible for repairing the damages made to the equipment's and plant of GMDC and compensate for the cost of damages.

13. Liquidated Damages (LD)

- 13.1** Time and quality are the essence of the contract and successful bidder has to complete the work accordingly. Looking to this, if work is not completed as per work completion time limit (i.e. within 120 days after acceptance of LOA), the LD will be levies 0.5% of total contract value per day subject to maximum 10% of total contract value.
- 13.2** Incompletion of any work or part of the work found of the contract affecting to the operation and safety of equipment and manpower shall be considered non-completion of the work and may lead to liquidated damage.
- 13.3** Under any circumstances GMDC shall not be liable to pay any compensation to the successful bidder.
- 13.4** Any delay of starting / completion of work due to want of materials shall also lead to LD as per clause 13.1.
- 13.5** If the delay of getting DGMS, Electrical Inspector final approval occurs but the successful bidder has applied for the same in time, then this delay shall not be considered as delay attributable to the successful bidder. However, the Successful Bidder shall ensure to get the approval / clearance at the earliest. Payment shall be released only after submitting DGMS, Electrical inspector approval/ clearance.
- 13.6** GMDC reserves right to terminate the contract and get the balance work completed at the cost and risk of the Successful bidder if the work shall not be carried out up to the satisfaction of GMDC and not completed in time.
- 13.7** For calculation of LD, date of acceptance of LOA shall be the reference date.
- 13.8** The overall cap on total LD for delay in supply and / or works shall be 10% of total contract value.



14. Insurance

- 14.1** The Successful bidder shall take full responsibility to take all precautions to prevent loss or damage to the works or part thereof for any reasons whatsoever (except for reasons which are beyond control of the Successful bidder or act of God, e.g. flood, riots, war, earthquake, etc.) and shall at his own cost, repair and make good the loss/damage to the work so that on completion, the work shall be in good order and condition and in conformity with the requirements of the Contract and instructions of the Project Authority, if any.
- 14.2** The Successful bidder shall, at all times during the pendency of the Contract, indemnify the GMDC against all claims, damages or compensation under the provisions of the Employee's Compensation Act and shall take insurance policy covering all risk, claims, damages or compensation payable under the Employee's Compensation Act or under any other law relating thereto.
- 14.3** The Successful bidder shall ensure that the insurance policy/policies are kept alive till full expiry of the Contract by timely payment of premiums and shall not be cancelled without the approval of the GMDC. The cost of premiums shall be borne by the Successful bidder, and it shall be deemed to have been included in the tendered rate.
- 14.4** In the event of the Successful bidder's failure to effect or to keep in force the insurance referred to above or any other insurance which the Successful bidder is required to effect under the terms of the Contract, the GMDC may effect and keep in force any such insurance and pay such premium/premiums as may be necessary for that purpose from time to time and recover the amount thus paid from any moneys due by the Successful bidder.

15. Goods & Service Tax

- 15.1** All bidders are required to submit their GST number and date in the bid. Bid received from unregistered bidder will not be considered and out rightly rejected.
- 15.2** Bidders are requested to quote their rates without GST. GST will be paid/adjusted/reimbursed to the Successful bidder as per prevailing rates and rules to the extent directly related to the services rendered OR Goods supplied by the Successful



bidder under the said contract subject to production of documentary proof and Successful bidder will mention the GST amount separately in the invoice/bill along with SAC/HSN Code under GST.

16. Payment

16.1 Successful bidder shall submit the invoice to the office of the General Manager (Project) for supplying of materials along with material challan copy, GMDC gate entry verification copy, Materials received and Inspection by GMDC sign copy, Materials test, and guarantee/warranty certificate within 15 days of material supply (T₁). Successful bidder shall have to supply the material as per work intimated by GMDC and Payment will be made as per the same.

16.2 Successful bidder shall submit the invoice to the office of the General Manager (Project) within 7 days of completion of installation work (T₂). Successful bidder shall have to finish the installation as per work intimated by GMDC and Payment will be made as per the same.

16.2 Successful bidder shall submit the invoice to the office of the General Manager (Project) within 7 days of completion of the works for actual work executed by agency including testing and commissioning (T₃). Payment shall be processed after execution of work order and submission of following documents:

- i. Details of Work carried out with work joint measurement sheet (GMDC electrical engineer and successful bidder).
- ii. Drawings, Layout and Test Certificates, Approval / Compliances Certificates from DGMS, Electrical Inspector etc.
- iii. MOM held with GMDC

Note:

- (1) Successful bidder has to make main gate entry on the supplied material and material is to be credited to Electrical store only.



- (2) Only after verification from GMDC, the materials shall be issued to the successful bidder through local EIC of GMDC.
- (3) Bills for works and Spares, consumables, equipment and Material with Price bid Sr. No to be put up for verification and tracking.
- (4) Compliance of all law relevant with the work carried out by successful bidder such as Labour Act, Mines Act pertaining to Mines etc.
- (5) Payment shall be done only as per actual quantity of work carried out / material supplied by the successful bidder.

17. Mode of Payment

The mode of payment will be by RTGS.

The contract amount is divided into divisions, that is material cost and Labour cost (Price Bid Form PP)

The payment will be done in following instalments-

- i. 50% of material cost and 50% of labour cost after material supply
- ii. 20% of material cost and 20% of labour cost after installation & erection
- iii. 30% of material cost and 30% of labour cost after testing, commissioning and DGMS approval

The Running Account bills, submitted at the office of General Manager (Project) will be processed there considering following deductions.

17.1 Income tax as per provision of Income Tax Act, and other Taxes (and surcharges) shall be applicable in force from time to time.

17.2 Cost of any other services provided / material supplied plus 15% administrative charge, if any, by the GMDC.

17.3 Liquidated damages liable as per clause No.13 of the Tender Document

Other deductions if any:



- 17.4** An ad-hoc payment @ 80% of the payable amount arrived after considering above deduction, will be paid by office of the G.M.[Project], within 15 days so submission of the bill along with its details.

The bill shall then be sent to GMDC's Corporate Office at Ahmedabad for verification, auditing and approval. Balance 20% payable amount of Running account bills shall become payable by Project only within two weeks of the receipt of the approved bill from Corporate Office.

18. Statutory Obligations

- 18.1** That the Successful Bidder shall pay wages and benefits in accordance with the applicable laws and shall not pay less than as notified by the Government Authorities from time to time and shall maintain the employment records as required under applicable laws.
- 18.2** That the Successful Bidder shall get his own License under Contract Labor (Regulation and Abolition) Act and The Code on Wages, 2019; The Industrial Relations Code, 2020; Social Security, 2020; The Occupational Safety, Health & Working Conditions (OSHC) Code, 2020. It shall be binding to get the same renewed from time to time and shall maintain all the records as per the act.
- 18.3** That the Successful Bidder shall be responsible to enroll his employees, deduct, add and deposit in the relevant accounts the contributions as required under the Four New Labour Code i.e. Code on Wages, 2019; Industrial Relations Code, 2020; Code on Social Security, 2020; Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020 and Employees State Insurance Act, 1952 and the Employees Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952 and any other enactment's covered under the various applicable labour laws as well as maintain all books of records for the staff and employees deputed by it for this contract such as required under any laws applicable. The Successful Bidder shall also furnish a copy of such statements as documentary proof to the GMDC.
- 18.4** The successful bidder shall have to take appropriate insurance cover in terms of Code on Social Security, 2020 or take Group Personal Accident Policy for all the employees deputed at the project site.



- 18.5** The Successful Bidder has to issue to the employee's Identity card with their photos and shall also maintain relevant register.
- 18.6** That the Successful Bidder shall give leave/holiday to its workforce as per the provisions of labour laws applicable.
- 18.7** Every person deployed by the Successful bidder in a mine must wear safety gadgets to be provided by the Successful bidder.
- 18.8** Any statutory clearance, permission required for the work, its completion, commissioning shall be in bidder's scope.
- 18.9** The Successful bidder will be required to obtain License from the office of the Labour Commissioner for the required strength of labour, before commencement of work at site and the same shall be maintained updated and valid throughout the currency of the contract.
- 18.10** That the Successful Bidder would obey with all applicable laws and maintain all such necessary records as necessitated under such enactments.
- 18.11** The successful Bidder shall have to follow Mines Act 1952, CENTRAL ELECTRICITY AUTHORITY (MEASURES RELATING TO SAFETY AND ELECTRIC SUPPLY) REGULATIONS, 2023, DGMS circulars issued from time to time, Environment Protection Act, Minimum Wages Act, P.F. Act and related Labour laws applicable and maintain registers, records etc. in prescribed format, under the laws.
- 18.12** The Successful bidder shall comply with other statutory provisions of Law. The Successful bidder shall comply with all applicable laws, ordinances, approved standards, rules and regulations, and shall procure all necessary municipal and governmental permits, licenses and inspection and shall pay all fees and charges in connection with the items covered by the contract. The Successful bidder shall serve GMDC harmless as a result of any in factions thereof. Successful bidder will be solely liable for all non-compliances. The following are some of the major Government of India Acts and Regulations to be complied with by the Successful Bidder. The List is illustrative and not exhaustive.
- The Mines Act,1952 and the relevant legislation there to.



- The Electricity Act, 2003 and rules made there under.
- The Code on Wages, 2019
- The Industrial Relations Code, 2020
- the Code on Social Security, 2020
- Occupational Safety, Health and Working Conditions Code, 2020

18.13 When, any work is performed at night or where daylight is poor or obscured, the successful bidder shall have to provide artificial lights at its own cost, wherever required on high towers. The illumination at the working site should be sufficient to carry out mining operation properly and safely with due approval of General Manager (Project)/ Mines Manager. The lighting standards shall be as prescribed by DGMS.

18.14 Electricity and water shall be provided from existing points by GMDC free of cost. Transportation / transmission shall be in successful bidder's scope.

18.15 The successful bidder shall be responsible to construct and maintain proper and adequate fencing, lighting guarding and taking necessary safety measures for all works under the contract as may be necessary or guided by the General Manager (Project) / Mines Manager at their cost.

18.16 Planning and Design shall be approved from the General Manager (Project) / Mines Manager and certified from Electrical Inspector, DGMS, required under law by the Successful bidder's scope.

18.17 The Successful bidder shall also indemnify the GMDC against any claims, compensations, damages, loss, liquidated damages etc. for breach and / or non-fulfillment of the prevailing Rules and Regulations and other statutory provisions in force from time to time and applicable to the work during the currency of contract.

18.18 If any amount becomes payable by GMDC as a result of any claim or application in terms of the provisions or non-compliance of provision of the any Acts and the Rules and Regulations, By-laws or the Orders made there under, applicable from time to time, such amounts shall be recoverable from the Successful bidder for which GMDC will not be responsible for any compensation.



19. Performance Guarantee

- 19.1** Successful bidder has to give performance guarantee for Supplied Material and Workmanship for 36 months from the date of completion of work and commissioning.
- 19.2** The 10% SD shall also be treated as performance Guarantee for the above specified period.
- 19.3** The performance guarantees for all the supplied materials shall be 36 months from date of completion of work.
- 19.4** The Performance BG / Security Deposit will be returned to your entity after 36 months of the completion of work and commissioning.
- 19.5** If any problem surfaces, the successful bidder shall carry out of repairing/ replacing the material or carry out work free of cost. All types of expenses for repair, replacement, labour, insurance, statutory etc shall be in successful bidder's scope.

The guarantee covers all types causes of non-satisfactory performance except natural calamities.

20. Bankruptcy

If the Successful bidder commits an act of Bankruptcy or goes into liquidation except for construction purposes, or if its business is carried on by a receiver, such receiver, liquidator or any person in whom the contract may become vested shall forthwith give notice thereof in writing to GMDC and in reasonable time during which he shall take all reasonable steps to prevent stoppage of performance of the contract, have the option of carrying out the contract subject to his or their providing such guarantees as may be required by GMDC but not exceeding the value of the work for the time being remaining unexecuted.

In the event of stoppage of performance under the contract, the period of option under this clause shall be decided by GMDC considering the situation, provided that the above option is not exercised, GMDC may terminate the contract by serving notice in writing to the Successful bidder. The power and provision so reserved to GMDC on taking of the work out of the Successful bidder's hands shall apply as far as they may be when the contract is so terminated.



21. Notice

Written notice shall be deemed to have been duly served if delivered to the individual or to Successful bidder or to the Signing Authority of the GMDC from whom it is intended, or if delivered at or sent by mail or post, to the last business address known to him who gives the notice.

22. Canvassing Not Permitted

22.1 Bidder should not canvass their offer personally or otherwise by approaching the Chairman or the Member of GMDC. If any Bidder wants to make any representation regarding his offer, he should write to the General Manager (Project) if he desires, but personal and oral representations are not permitted.

22.2 In spite of the above clear instructions, any Bidder is found to canvass his offer or against his competitor's offer through personal approach to the competent authority or the officials of GMDC, their offer will be rejected without assigning any reason and the firm even is blacklisted.

23. Non-Fulfillment of Terms and Condition of The Contract

If the Successful bidder fails to carry out the work as per terms and conditions of the contract to the satisfaction of the GMDC, GMDC shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit paid by the Successful bidder. This, however, shall not absolve the Successful bidder from his obligation to fulfill the contract. In such event, the GMDC shall have a right to complete and / or to get the work completed at the cost & risk of the Successful bidder and the Successful bidder shall be responsible to pay such cost incurred by the GMDC to complete the work and/or to get the work completed.

Likewise, if the Successful bidder does not fulfill the terms and conditions of the contract and does not carry out the work up to the entire satisfaction of GMDC, GMDC has the right to forthwith terminate the contract at its sole discretion, without assigning any reason, Under such events, the GMDC shall be entitled to forfeit the security deposit paid by the Successful bidder and the GMDC shall have a right to complete the work and / or to get the work completed at the risk and cost of the Successful bidder.



For any reasons, if it is required, the GMDC reserves rights to cancel, terminate, amend and / or alter the contract and / or bifurcate and / or reduce the contract work at any time without giving any notice or reason to the Successful bidder and without incurring any responsibility. For such cases, Successful bidder shall have to take away his labour, tools, tackles, machinery, equipment etc. and shall leave the site at once or shall have to carry out the instructions of the GMDC.

24. General Conditions

1. All the persons of the Successful bidder engaged inside the mines working area must wear Helmet and Shoes and other PPEs. As and when required other personal protective wears shall also be provided to them by the successful bidder to follow mines act.
2. The Successful bidder shall take adequate statutorily prescribed insurance cover for all men and machinery engaged by him/it for performance of the work at site. Any insurance claim brought against the GMDC by an individual or by customers or by any such other persons who suffered damage due to negligence of the Successful bidder or his employees, the same shall be settled by the successful bidder at his cost.
3. The Successful bidder has to ensure supervision of the work through duly qualified and competent persons and also has to make sure that a responsible Manager/ Engineer full time available on work site to whom GMDC can issue the instruction and who can fulfill such instructions. Successful bidder shall appoint qualified Manpower.
4. The Successful bidder shall not change the constitution of the firm/name during the currency of the contract without prior approval of GMDC. Upon such change in constitution and/or name, Supplementary agreement to that effect shall be executed and if the SD is submitted in form of BG/FD than fresh BG in the name and/or constitution shall be submitted failing which necessary action as deemed fit by GMDC shall be taken.
5. All the staff members of the successful bidder shall carry Photo Identity Card while on duty.
6. The successful bidder shall provide necessary arrangement for transportation of manpower from Township or other locations to work site with all the required safety provisions/devices enforced by statutory authority and other applicable laws/rules or as directed by GMDC authority.



7. All the equipment to be deployed by the successful bidder must be maintained in proper working order and be fitted with all the required safety devices enforced by statutory authority e.g. Audio-Visual Alarms, fire extinguisher etc.
8. In case of any Central/State Government directives regarding mines and / or electrical works execution of work related thereto, the same shall have to be strictly adhered to and binding upon the successful bidder for implementation, for which GMDC will not be responsible for any compensation.
9. The successful bidder shall abide by the provision of the Motor Vehicle Act for machinery. Any consequences arising out of non-compliance of said Provisions will be at the successful bidder's sole risk and cost, for which GMDC will not be responsible for any compensation.
10. To meet the exigencies arising out of natural calamities or disaster or during any emergency, GMDC reserves the right to take away any of the equipment's / machineries deployed at the project site with a mutually consented rate. A separate agreement will be made to this effect.
11. MD-GMDC is authorized to take suitable decision and action in case of requirement to amend / alter the work order conditions /quantities of the works / extension of the work completion period / allotment of additional works / revision of the rates of the work etc. if necessary, in the interest of GMDC.

25. Termination of Contract

If at any time during the currency of this contract, if any breach occurs due to the reasons attributed to the Successful bidder, GMDC shall be at liberty to terminate this contract without assigning any reasons, whatsoever, for such termination and any losses and/or damages occurring due to such termination shall be borne by the Successful bidder. GMDC shall be entitled to forfeit Security deposits as Liquidated damages.

26. Governing Law

This Tender and subsequent Contract shall be construed and interpreted in accordance with and governed by the laws of India.



27. Jurisdiction

The matter related to any dispute or difference arising out of this Tender and subsequent contract shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of Court at Ahmedabad only.

28. Arbitration

All questions, disputes, differences whatsoever which may at any time arises between the parties to this Tender and subsequent contract in connection with the Tender and subsequent contract or any matter arising out of or in relation thereto, shall be referred to Sole Arbitrator as per the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and subsequent amendment thereto and the venue of arbitration proceedings shall be at Ahmedabad only. The Language of the Arbitration shall be in English only.

29. Completion of Work

29.1 Upon the Successful bidder fulfilling the entirety of its obligations under the Contract to the satisfaction of GMDC and subject to terms and conditions of the Contract, it shall become eligible to apply for a Completion Certificate. The General Manger (Project) of GMDC shall formally issue the Completion Certificate, after verifying from the completion documents and satisfying himself that the Works under the Contract have been completed in accordance with all the provisions of this Contract. The Successful bidder, after obtaining the Completion Certificate shall become eligible to present the final bill for the Works executed by it under the Contract.

29.2 Upon completion of Works under the Contract and before the application for the Completion Certificate, the Successful bidder shall clear the project of GMDC of all rubbish, dirt, structures, scrap, oily rags etc. Failure to clear the project may constrain GMDC to clear the said site at the risk and cost of the Successful bidder.

29.3 The Successful bidder shall provide GMDC with any and all documents/records/proofs that may be demanded before issuance of Completion Certificate.

30. Accident and Responsibilities of Bidder

30.1 The entire responsibility on account of any accidents, damage or personal injury which may occurred to any of the Successful bidder's vehicles/ equipments or his/its employees or any



outside party shall be exclusively that of the Successful bidder and no claim whatsoever shall be entertained by the GMDC on this account. The Successful bidder shall keep the GMDC indemnified from all the consequences.

- 30.2** In the event of any breakdown or accident during the course of any operation, the Successful bidder shall notify the facts to the GMDC Authority or any other officer immediately present there of such incidence and shall simultaneously make adequate remedial arrangements on his/its own cost and risk and as per the instruction of the Authority.
- 30.3** The Successful bidder shall pay all claims, damages and compensation with cost arising out of or resulting there from to the third party(s) and in case the GMDC would be required to face any proceedings all to pay any amount on the aforesaid account, it shall be deemed to have been discharge on behalf of the Successful bidder, the same amount shall be recovered half-an hour rest interval in between. The Successful bidder shall ensure that the attendance of all the supplied manpower shall be taken through biometric attendance machine.

31. Foreclosure

In case of any necessity arising due to local working conditions or any unforeseen reason not in the control of the GMDC or any reason whatsoever GMDC shall be at liberty to Foreclose the contract without assigning any reasons or notice there for.

32. Force Majeure

Force majeure is herein defined as any cause which is beyond the control of the Successful bidder or the GMDC as the case may be which they could not foresee or with a reasonable amount of diligence could not have foreseen and which substantially affect the performance of the contract, such as:

- 32.1** Natural phenomena such as flood, draughts Cyclone, earthquake and epidemics, declaration of war.
- 32.2** Acts of any government, including but not limited to war, declared or undeclared priorities, quantities, embargoes, providing either party shall within fifteen (15) days from the occurrence of such a cause notify the other in writing of such cases.



- 32.3** The Successful bidder will advise, in the event of his having resort to this clause by a registered letter duly certified by the statutory authorities, the beginning and end of the cause of delay, within fifteen days of the occurrence and cessation of such Force Majeure condition. In the event of delay lasting over two months, if arising out of Force Majeure, the contract may be terminated at the discretion of the GMDC.
- 32.4** For delay arising out of Force Majeure, the Successful bidder will not claim extension in completion date for a period exceeding the period of delay attributable to the causes of force Majeure and neither company nor the Successful bidder shall be liable to pay extra costs (like increase in rates, remobilization, advance, idle charges for labour and machinery etc.) provided it is mutually established that the Force Majeure conditions did actually exist.
- 32.5** If any of the Force Majeure conditions exists in the place of operation of the Successful bidder even at the time of submission of bid, he will categorically specify them in his bid and state whether they have been taken into consideration in their quotations.
- 32.6** The Successful bidder or the GMDC shall not be liable for delays in performing his obligations resulting from any force majeure causes referred to and / or defined above. The date of completion will, subject to hereinafter provided, be extended by a reasonable time.

33. Defect Liability Period (DLP)
